### **What happens when points are tied?**

The last few race rounds this has happened to a few of our guys so here is the MNZ rule: 6-14-1

Basically if two riders are on the same points and their position is equal it is worked out that the rider with the better placement i.e. over four races one of the riders best result was a 5<sup>th</sup> and the other riders best result was a 4<sup>th</sup> then it is the rider with the 4<sup>th</sup> result that would end up with the place. However if they both got equal placing i.e. over four races they both got 2 x 4<sup>th</sup> and 2 x 5<sup>th</sup> then it is the rider that got the better placement on the LAST race that would then get the better position and then the other rider would be put down to the next placing.

## **2009 MotoSouth Cross Country Series Wrap-up**

The cross country season has once again drawn to a close for another year already. This year we held 5 rounds on in my opinion some of the best tracks to ride on in this country, and probably the world as abroad there are serious restrictions causing problems for off road riders. We are truly lucky here in NZ. For those who are not familiar with Cross Country, they are 2hr races (1hr for Juniors) over various terrains and the course is normally around 14 to 20kms. The start is dead engine Le Mans style (run to your bike, start it and go) and the rider who completes the most laps wins. Wicked fun.

The series kicked off at Mararoa Station near Te-Anau mid February. We had great entries with riders coming down from Central Otago and Dunedin to mix it up with local club members. The day was hot and sunny, and combined with a physical track was very demanding for most riders as the first up event. The race started beside Lake Thomas, and raced past every lap making this event a true spectacle and giving it a special feeling all of its own.

Round 2 was Belmont Station in Blackmount and we also incorporated Round 1 of the South Island Cross Country Champs as well. This meant we had riders from afar as Nelson to compete, and the most numbers I have ever seen at one of our events. The Juniors raced without a hitch, the normal 1hr race and those doing the SI Champs raced for a further ½ hr. Great results here from SMCC members proving that our strong series is producing awesome cross country riders. The seniors lined up for their race and then the rain came, not heavy but wet all the same. This on top of the ground which was rock hard made the 17km course more like an ice skating rink. After 1hr it was decided to stop the race as a badly injured rider lying near the track needed medical attention, and a hill had become virtually impassable for all but a few. Further assessment of the rider resulted in a chopper being called and him being airlifted to hospital, and when this was all done it was too late in the day to restart the race. This was unfortunate, especially for those that travelled far, but was obviously out of our hands. It was really cool to see the amount of SMCC riders who had hardened up and taken the opportunity to race the SI Champs which is a 3hr race, 1hr more than normal. Hopefully next year we get the chance to do it again and more people can get to experience a 3hr race.

Next stop was Richard Simpson's at Dipton. Richard's place is that good you would think it has been carved out of the ground especially for cross country. Richard has also been holding races on his place for an unbelievable 21 yrs, and with his farm on the market, this could be the last year. Special thanks must go out to Richard for all his support of dirt biking, it is truly appreciated. Race day conditions were perfect, thankfully no casualties and a great day had by all.

Round 4 and a brand new venue at Chimneys Station just north of Wreys Bush. Numbers were starting to dwindle a bit by now. This seems to happen every year as the series goes on, I guess due to injuries, other commitments or bike issues. Still plenty riding but it would be nice if more would commit to the series. Rain was forecasted and when I arrived it was absolutely heaving it down. Someone was looking after us because an hour later the clouds parted and we enjoyed a clear sunny day. Having a new venue was neat, new obstacles and hazards to contend with to make things interesting. If anyone took the time to look (which they shouldn't have been if they were racing!) they would have noticed the awesome view from the highest point in the track of over the Southland plains right out to the sea.

5th and final round. Back at Richard Simpson's place to a new well thought out track. The juniors raced in good conditions although wet under foot. The seniors had their look lap in brilliant sunshine, but when they lined up to race it started hailing big time. The race was started in the hail storm, and off everyone went. If you can imagine standing in front of 1000 people shooting at you with pellet guns; that's what it felt like racing in the hail. When the hail stopped, the ground was white and that eventually melted turning the ground to slippery mud. It was probably the slipperiest mud I have raced in for 7 or 8 years. When everyone went to leave, most found themselves hopelessly stuck in the paddock, that was until Justin jumped into his 33" shod Hilux and towed them all out. Entertaining it was.

From here we had a bloody good prizegiving at Winton's Middle Pub and we managed to fill up their room upstairs thanks to everyone coming. The series was a huge success this year and I would like to thank the landowners – Tim Smith, Peter Gow, Richard Simpson and Dion White – for being fantastic to work with and for giving up their farms for us to race, we couldn't do it without them. Also I would like to thank my team of helpers, all mucking in doing track marking, lap scoring, track marshalling among other things. I hope I can have the same great help next year.
